General Overview of Ningbo Dahongying University

Ningbo Dahongying University, a private university invested by Ningbo Dahongying

Education Group, was founded in 2001, and upgraded as an undergraduate university

in 2008 with more than 1,000 teachers and around 20,000 students currently.

Based in Ningbo, a time-honored port city, it has two campuses, located in Yinzhou

District and Hangzhou Bay Zone respectively, the latter situated at the southern end of

the Hangzhou Cable Bridge. With an area of 115.89 hectares and a total construction

area of 540,000 m²°

With application-oriented undergraduate education as our mission, we make efforts to

create a university that serves Zhejiang Province and Yangtze River Delta, and has a

nationwide influence; we strive to have a balanced discipline development among

science, economics, management, humanities and arts so that we can nurture talents

specialized in information technology, manufacture, service and culture industries; we

devote to providing high-quality technology and management professionals for small

and medium-sized enterprises; and we commit to developing the university into a

first-rate teaching-oriented university with exemplifying value and distinctive

characteristics in China.

Currently the University has 11 second-level colleges: College of Information

Technology, College of Mechanical & Electrical Engineering, College Finance &

Trade, College of Business Administration, College of Wealth Management, College

of Arts & Media, College of Humanities, College of Electronic Commerce, College of

International Education, College of Basic Courses, College of Further Education, with

more than 30 undergraduate majors.

Study period and Academic Schedule

The normal period of study for each program is as follows: 4 years for undergraduate degrees. Students may, in particular cases, apply for early or delayed graduation.

Ningbo Dahongying University divides every academic year into spring and autumn semesters, with the latter marking the commencement of the academic year. The autumn semester starts in September and ends in the end of January of the following year while the spring semester begins in the beginning of February and ends in the beginning of July. There will be a winter and summer vacation every year. The summer vacation usually lasts 2 months. The winter vacation lasts 4 weeks and normally coincides with the Chinese New Year. The starting date of every semester differs yearly, depending on the time of the Chinese New Year. Please check the latest academic calendar for details.

Programs

International students have the following options of study at Ningbo Dahongying University:

- (1) Undergraduate programs;
- (2) Visiting students program (non-degree granting);
- (3) Pre-university program;
- (4) Summer program;
- (5) Short-term language courses or Chinese studies programs.

Applicants must be non-Chinese citizens with good health, valid passport, above the age of 18, and should abide by Chinese law and the regulations of Ningbo Dahongying University. They should also respect Chinese social customs.

Undergraduate program: Students are required to complete the curriculum within 4 to 8 years and fulfill the designated number of credits. Successful graduates will receive a graduation certificate along with a bachelor's degree, according to the regulation of the Degree Committee.

Visiting Students Program: Candidates must have completed at least one year of undergraduate study at their own university. The following options are available for joining undergraduate courses or enhancing proficiency in the Chinese language:

- VS1: Overseas Universities with student exchange agreements with Ningbo
 Dahongying University may select students of non-Chinese nationality for an
 exchange program at Ningbo Dahongying University for a Chinese language
 course or specific undergraduate courses.
- VS2: International students awarded with Ningbo Government Scholarships or Ningbo Dahongying University Scholarships may take Chinese language courses or undergraduate courses at Ningbo Dahongying University.

Pre-University Program ("PUP") : The Pre-University Program ("PUP") of Ningbo Dahongying University aims to provide those outstanding high school graduates who are interested in studying at Ningbo Dahongying University as undergraduates with 1-2 years of preparatory Chinese and mathematics training. After the pre-university program, those who have good grades and good behavior can be given priority in the undergraduate admission process.

Language Proficiency Requirements

Visiting Students are required to take the Chinese or English language proficiency exam after registration. Only those students whose results meet the standard are allowed to take specialty courses, otherwise they are advised to study Chinese or English Language in the College of Humanities for one or two semesters. For those who have already received a certificate of the new HSK (Hanyu shuiping kaoshi) of level 3 or IELTS 5.5 and above, the Chinese or English language proficiency exam

will be exempted.

Undergraduates candidates are required to submit the certificate of Language Proficiency according to the regulations of different programs.

Application Processing

It takes at least 2 to 6 weeks after we received your application to send out the formal Letter of Admission. We may inform you to attend an interview or request additional materials according to your application process during this period. If you are accepted, we will send you a Letter of Admission and other relevant documents. To track the progress of your application, please contact the International Office either by email or telephone. Due to our limited staff, we may not reply promptly to all enquiries.

Visa

Successful applicants should bring their Letter of Admission and their JW202 form to the Chinese consulate or embassy to apply for their Student Visa. A study period of 6 months and above requires an X1 visa. Accepted applicants need to apply for exchanging their X1 visas to a Residence Permit at the International Office within 30 days of arrival in China. If your period of study is less than half a year, you may apply for an X2 visa.

Medical insurance

It is required that all international students must be medically insured throughout their entire planned period of study. Students are required to purchase the Comprehensive Insurance Plan of Foreign Students provided by Ping An insurance company on the day of registration, which has been recognized and recommended by the Chinese Ministry of Education. Students who do not have valid medical insurance are not allowed to register.

Accommodation information

NDU provides the housing facilities to all the international students. For further

You are allowed to your own living accommodation off campus. Please note that

students who live off campus must register at the local police station.
